# SC: Protesters can't occupy public spaces indefinitely

public ccupying places for protests is not acceptable and areas like Shaheen Bagh which had seen prolonged anti-CAA demonstrations starting December last vear — cannot be occupied "indefinitely", the Supreme Court held on Wednesday.

It said protests should be at a designated place and any occupation of public places or roads by demonstrators, which cause inconvenience to a large number of people and violate their rights, is not permissible under law. It also said



authorities concerned should not hide behind courts and act on their own in such situations. A Bench headed by Justice

struck between the right to protest and other public rights like the right to movement.

"Democracy and dissent hand in hand," said the Bench, also comprising Justices Aniruddha Bose and Krishna Murari.

It does not mean that the agitating people should adopt means and modes of protest that were used against colonial rulers, it said, adding that public places cannot be occupied "indefinitely" for protests like in the Shaheen Bagh case.

The verdict came on a plea of lawyer Amit Sahni against the blockade of a road in Shaheen Bagh area by persons

which aimed to provide Indian citizenship to persecuted minorities of Afghanistan and Bangladesh.

Pronouncing the verdict via video conferencing, the Bench said the authorities like Delhi Police ought to have taken action to clear Shaheen Bagh area from the protesters.

The top court had reserved its verdict in the case on September 21 by observing that there cannot be a "universal policy" on right to protest and possible curbs as also balancing it with acts like blocking of roads are needed because the situation may "vary" from case-to-case.

### Pricing freedom ...

According to the regulations, producers will not be allowed to participate in the bidding process. Their affiliate companies can participate in the price-discovery initiative. All these new discoveries will be governed by the new e-bidding mechanism and affiliate marketing mechanism, which will be managed by the Directorate General of Hydrocarbons (DGH), "The country produces around 84 mmscmd of natural gas and we import almost the same. The new pricing mechanism will help in coming up with 40 mmscmd additional production in KG basin only. This will reduce our dependency on natural gas imports," Pradhan said.

This won't have any impa existing pricing formula for natural gas under the administered price mechanism, which the government came out with in November 2014. The capping on prices for difficult fields will also continue in the existing format, the minister said. This comes after the prices touched a historic low of \$1.79 per million metric British thermal unit (mmBtu) for the October-March period of FY21, down 25 per cent from \$2.39 per mmBtu during April-September.

The government has reduced the ceiling price for gas produced from deepwater, ultra-deepwater and high-pressure and high-temperature areas by 28 per cent to \$4.06 per mmBtu for the period under review, as compared to \$5.61 per mmBtu during the April-September period of 2020. The current prices are the lowest in the last six years, since the new pricing system was implemented in November 2014.

Infrastructure projects in India are seldom completed on time with issues like land acquisition, availability of finance affecting them. The second international airport in Mumbai was slated to open in 2019, but has been delayed with the current deadline being 2021.

While the first phase will have one runway and cater to 12 million passengers, by the fourth phase Zurich plans to have two runways and cater to 70 million passengers. The total investment in the first phase of the project will be ₹4,666 crore.

Arun Veer Singh, CEO of Yamuna Expressway Development Authority (YEIDA), said 5,000 hectare is available for ect and this can be increased based on necessity.

PwC, which was tasked with conducting a techno feasibility study of the airport, has suggested that the airport can sustain five runways. "PwC gave a presentation on techno-economic feasibility report on Friday, informing us that three more runways are feasible on the 5,000 hectare notified for the airport at Jewar, bringing total runway capacity to five," Singh said.

However, Bircher said planning for the next phase will begin only when the airport attains 80 per cent of projected passenger growth.

While it has been named the Noida International Airport and is situated 70 kms from Delhi, the project has been pitched as Delhi's second airport and will compete against GMR-owned Indira Gandhi International Airport. Christoph Schnellman, CEO of the Noida airport, said that while the airport expects some spillover traffic from Delhi, the primary aim will be to target the catchment area of Noida, Greater Noida and Western UP.

### TCS beats...

"It (Q2) has been a very strong quarter from a financial perspective. It also underlines demand recovery and it sets us up in participating in technology transformation in the medium to long term," said Rajesh Gopinathan, CEO and MD. "If you see the revenue performance in dollar terms. it is our best performance in more than 20 quarters.'

The company called the recovery happening in the second quarter a "pleasant surprise". TCS had earlier predicted reaching pre-Covid levels of ₹40,000 crore in revenues in the December quarter.

However, Gopinathan sounded cautious when he said the overall business environment was not "out of the woods" because Covid-19 was there.

Growth in Q2 was led by two key verticals - retail; and banking, financial services and insurance (BFSI) – which account for more than 50 per cent of its revenues. The company declared an interim dividend of ₹12 per share. The record date has been fixed on October 15.

"The idea of setting up an SSE, which has not taken off successfully anywhere, is premature. It is ironic that on the one hand. the government is shrinking civic space through changes in the corporate social responsibility (CSR) laws and FCRA laws and, on the other, is talking about creating a new mechanism for capital flows into areas of work that the government would like to see happen," added Patnaik.

Fundamentally, the idea is flawed because if you want to ease business for NGOs, it has to be looked at holistically and must cover all areas of non-profit regulation. A level playing field, including for foreign capital inflows, would be a good first step instead of the proposed added Patnaik.

Some of these concerns among civil societies were raised at a recent meeting with the Ministry of Finance, while discussing SSEs, another source said, adding the regulator would need to take a cautious approach, as NGOs could be vulnerable to risks of money laundering.

So far, the Sebi-appointed working group defined the core approach and now the technical committee is working on details such as eligibility criteria, impact and financial reporting standards, and how social impact auditors and information repositories would function. The technical group will likely submit its report by the end of this year and then would seek finance ministry approval. Notably, the regulator has not accepted any of the recommendations of the working group.

Ingrid Srinath, director-Centre for Social Impact and Philanthropy, Ashoka University, and a panellist of Sebi's technical team, said: "NGOs have already been submitting information to various authorities as well as to their own donors in a very detailed manner. The goal here is to attract new capital to the non-profit sector.... The goal is to attract investors who have never invested in the social sector."

She further said the platform and the new instruments aim to provide a sense of legitimacy, transparency, and build their confidence to invest in social causes. Initially, there may be only a few thousand organisations eligible for listing, but as the ecosystem develops, more players would come on board.

The data suggests that India has nearly 3.4-million NGOs catering to areas as diverse as disaster relief and advocacy for needy communities.
